# 2018 Nesma IT Forum: Are You Prepared?



Are You Prepared?" was the title of Nesma's 2018 IT Forum held at Nesma Training Center in Jeddah. The forum this year shed light on information security and aimed to raise awareness about potential risks and threats of today's rapidly evolving forms of information.

The IT forum agenda included a keynote presentation by Nesma Holding's IT Executive Manager, Mubarak Alshahrani, highlighting various technical advancements along with their potential threats.

Following was a presentation by Midhat Amer, a speaker from Gartner, an American research and advisory firm. Amer shared security-related insights and gave advice on building successful organizations.

Another presentation was given by Ahmed Eid and Ben Rzouga from iSolutions, a premium partner of Google in the Middle East. Eid and Rzouga talked about the latest threats and solutions within the information security paradigm in addition to talking about new features in Google G-Suite.

Nesma Telecom & Technology was awarded a SAR 38.6 million contract by Dawiyat, a subsidiary of the Saudi Electricity Company.

Nesma Telecom & Technology's scope of work includes the survey, design and implementation of the entire fiber optic network infrastructure to meet GPON/NGPON2 standards and provide at least 100Mb/s to 12,663 households in As-Salam district, Riyadh.

The project, undertaken in a record of 3-month period, included 1600km of ducting and 680km of fiber optic cable to serve the entire district and its 4460 buildings.

Nesma Holding Cricket Team participated in the first T10 Tournament in Jeddah, organized by WPCA and bringing together 23 different teams.


Nesma's team won all the games in the Tournament until it finally grabbed the championship trophy in the final game against ATC.
