Jazan Contract For Nesma Security


The city of Jazan has awarded a 36-month contract to Nesma Security valued at more than SAR 84 million. The company will provide 24/7 security for basic and downstream industries including residential neighborhoods, light and heavy industry areas, secondary roads and roads adjacent to the city. نسما للأمين Nesma Security

To fulfill the contract, Nesma Security will utilize 18 new security vehicles and employ 250 Saudi security officers, fueling the company's continued growth.

Nesma Water & Energy Wins Al-Hafuf Project



NW&E has been awarded a project to design, build and commission a potable water pumping station to provide clean drinking water to the residents of Al-Hafuf in the eastern region of Saudi Arabia. This project, valued at SAR 125 million, involves the construction of a storage tank with 38,200m³ capacity, a 65-meter tall, one-million gallon steel elevated tank which will incorporate solar panels to offset energy consumption, a pump house and other buildings related to the station's operations. This contract also serves to strengthen the relationship with client ROSHN Real Estate Co. The project is being designed in-house at NW&E.

MASAR Project Soft Opening

Nesma & Partners announces the soft opening of the Al Mansour road & Mansour underpass. Since the start of the project in mid-2020, the team has successfully navigated numerous challenges including the diversion and relocation of hundreds of meters of water, sewage and telecommunications lines. The scope of work involved 127 girders, 7200 m² of asphalt, 20,000m³ of concrete and 2000m² of GRC cladding.



This project is part of the Kingdom's Vision 2030 plan for urban renewal and development of infrastructure.


