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### Nesma Security Wins Riyadh Metro Contracts







Nesma Security has signed security contracts with the two official Riyadh Metro operators. Both the ten-year CAMCO contract for lines 1 & 2, and the five-year Rekeep/Flow contract for lines 3,4,5 and 6 can be extended for an additional five years. The projected total Saudi security staff needed to implement these contracts will exceed 750 employees when the metro is fully operational. The scope of work across the 85 depots and stations includes

preventing and controlling unauthorized persons, responding to emergency incidents and escorting cash handling teams. Valued at well over SAR 400 million, they represent the largest contracts Nesma Security has had to date and an important milestone for the company.

Nesma Security is the only approved security service contractor for Riyadh Metro.

### Namat Partners With TasHeel Group



### NTC Hosts Leadership Training



In October, Nesma Training Center held a five-day training on "Developing Innovative Leaders for the Digital Age."
