








# Nesma & Partners Wins Red Sea International Airport Project




The Red Sea Development Company has awarded a contract to a joint venture between Nesma & Partners and Almabani General Contractors to build infrastructure for the Red Sea International Airport.

The contract covers the airport's essential airside infrastructure works, including the design and building of a 3,700-meter code F runway, code B seaplane runway, parallel & link taxiways and pavement works, aeronautical navigational aids, aerodrome ground lighting, airside utilities, helipads, roads and associated buildings.

"This award marks the start of our exciting partnership with The Red Sea Development Company, who are on track to deliver a world-class sustainable giga-project in support of Saudi's Vision 2030. We are proud to be selected to contribute to the development of the Red Sea International Airport which we believe will play a key role in the transformation of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia by welcoming up to one million visitors per year to the destination by 2030," said Rami Alturki, Vice Chairman, Nesma & Partners.



As part of the eco-friendly Red Sea project, the Red Sea Airport will open up Saudi Arabia to the world. The first phase of the Red Sea project will provide 3,000 luxurious hotel rooms across five islands and two inland sites located between the cities of Umluj and Al Wajh on the west coast of Saudi Arabia.



Nesma & Partners' success in securing new projects comes from its commitment to excellence at every turn. This month, a letter received by the Chairman of the Board, Sh. Abdulaziz Al-Turki, demonstrates this commitment.

## Nesma Renewables Group Awarded Jeddah 300MW Solar PV Project

A consortium made of Nesma Renewables Group, Masdar and EDFR was awarded the Jeddah 300MW solar PV project which is part of the National Renewable Energy Project Development Program.

Round Two of the National Renewable Energy Project is comprised of four Solar PV independent power producers (IPP) totaling 1,400 MW, including Al-Faisaliah PV IPP (600 MW), Jeddah PV IPP (300 MW), Rabigh PV IPP (300 MW) and Qurrayat PV IPP (200 MW).

# Nesma Trading: From Riyadh Metro to Saudi Customs Authority

The Business Ventures Division in Nesma Trading has recently completed monitoring and instrumentation services at lines 1 & 2 for BACS Consortium at the Riyadh Metro Project.

The scope of work included monitoring the project's critical infrastructure such as roads, bridges, ministerial buildings and high rise towers.

In addition, Nesma Trading completed the tagging and verification of assets for the Saudi Customs Authority in 51 Saudi customs sites across the kingdom including the headquarters

buildings in Riyadh, along with airports, seaports and landports in Riyadh, Jeddah, Dammam and Abha.

Moreover, Aramco Aviation awarded Nesma Trading the airfield lighting upgrade at the Hawtah Aramco Aviation Airstrip, a contract valued at SAR 4.2 million.

Nesma's scope of work includes upgradation of the airfield ground lighting system from low to high intensity lighting including design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning.

### Nesma Water Taxi Resumes

As the coronavirus lockdown has now eased in Mansoura City, Egypt, Nesma Water Taxi has resumed its operations and soon will be launching its restaurant boat, on the occasion of the Eid al-Adha holiday.

The Water Taxi is still following all COVID precautions and will enforce face mask policies as it transports up to 1000 customers per day.

Nesma Water Taxi connects metropolitan Cairo with a system of boats operating on a closed loop



route on the Nile River, transporting commuters and tourists to their destinations.
