On February 14th, Nesma Co. celebrated its 44th anniversary. Nesma Co. Signs MOU for Zero Emissions Transport

Nesma Co. has signed a strategic partnership MOU with a group of companies from Hong Kong to bring sustainable and zero emissions public and cargo transportation solutions to Saudi Arabia. This partnership aims to support the Saudi Vision 2030 and its objective to achieve carbon neutrality in the future.

As part of this partnership, hydrogen fuel cell and EV-based public buses, intercity buses, semi-trucks and logistics vans will be designed and manufactured according to the needs of Saudi Arabia initially for NEOM and the Red Sea developments. This initiative will not only promote sustainable transportation but also generate employment opportunities in the region.

The signing event occurred in Riyadh at the Investment Forum sponsored by the Ministry of Investment. The MOU was signed by Cliff Zhang, who has a lead role in each of the three Hong Kong companies and Nesma Company Chairman



Fouad Alsherebi in the presence of H.E. Khalid Al-Falih, Minister of Investment. This partnership marks an important milestone in the journey towards sustainable development and highlights the commitment of Nesma Co. to supporting the Saudi Vision 2030.

Nesma & Partners IKTVA Award & New MOU



Nesma & Partners, along with Saudi Aramco, was a platinum sponsor of IKTVA 2023 and was honored with the IKTVA Excellence Award for Highest Overall IKTVA Performance in the Construction Sector.

The company also signed an MOU with Tarmeem, their CSR strategic partner, to launch the Saudi Contracting Pioneer Initiative seeking to elevate the quality and quantity of renovation projects in the Kingdom, support local startup contractors and contribute to the local content. Nesma & Partners will join with Tarmeem to attract and support several local startup contracting companies to renovate and rehabilitate houses for those families most in need. In its first phase, the initiative is expected to attract ten contractors to renovate 50 houses. Nesma & Partners will provide training and advisory support to the startup companies. Nesma & Partners and Tarmeem hope this initiative will have an additional impact on supporting local content by adopting restoration material from emerging local building material companies. It is worth noting that since the inception of their strategic partnership, Tarmeem has rehabilitated over 80 houses sponsored by Nesma & Partners.

IKTVA which stands for "in Kingdom total value add," is a Saudi Aramco initiative required of all of its contractors and suppliers that increases the utilization of local goods and services. The IKTVA Forum & Exhibition provided an opportunity for networking and developing opportunities for localization within the industry.

It also prepares them to use the new, mandatory SABER portal system for clearing imported goods through Saudi Arabia's customs requirements. The 20-day program was attended by 45 trainees. Trainings such as these support the expansion of Nesma Training Center's community service programs.




Namat Offers Unique Founding Day Abayas


