NT&T Awarded NEOM Contracts



Nesma Telecom & Technology has been awarded the implementation of the NEOM Community Internal CCTV Enhancement project in NEOM basecamp. This project augments the physical monitoring infrastructure for security protecting NEOM's community area with cutting edge technologies and advanced features. The scope of the project includes design, supply, implementation, operation and maintenance services for all deployed CCTV systems.

Nesma Telecom & Technology has also won a contract for the implementation of the Biometric Access Control System project, also at the NEOM Basecamp. This project enhances the access control infrastructure for NEOM's community area with multiple authentications, access rights and advanced features. The scope of the project includes, design, supply, implementation, operation and maintenance services for all deployed biometric access control systems.

NEOM, which means "New Future," is Saudi Arabia's futuristic city being built along the Red Sea in the northwestern corner of the country. The city will be run entirely on renewable energy and will focus on new, clean industries such as digital sciences, biotech and technology. An expression of the Kingdom's Vision 2030, NEOM is planned to be an internationally minded hub for innovation and a model of urban sustainability.

N&P Completes KKIA Terminal Apron Extension in Record Time

Nesma President Sponsors Al-Jouf Award



Faisal Al-Turki, President of Nesma Co., is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Al-Jouf Award for Excellence and Creativity in Business, and also its sponsor. "The participation of Nesma Company in sponsoring the award comes to enhance its social presence in the Al-Jouf region as part of its ambitious strategy in the Dumat Al-Jandal wind energy project," says Al-Turki. Through the Nesma Renewables Group, Nesma is part of a partnership with Masdar and EDF participating in the installation of the largest wind power generation plant in the Middle East. As the first wind farm in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, it exemplifies the 2030 vision and goals to diversify energy sources in the Kingdom.

This pilot project, currently under construction, is designed with a capacity of 400 megawatts, which is sufficient to power about 70 thousand homes, and is able to compete with conventional energy in terms of cost. The economic and societal impact will include creating job opportunities in the construction, operation and maintenance stages, in addition to a related business economy. Moreover, the expected environmental impact is wide, as the project will contribute to reducing energy linked carbon emissions and preserving the environment, while at the same time demonstrating the wind farm's ability to provide electricity for multiple uses in the Kingdom. Locally, the project will provide educational opportunities for students in the region to learn about environmental issues.

Nesma Rise Update

The sessions which have already been conducted covered a variety of topics relating to one of the following areas: "governance & compliance," "health, safety & environment" or "product & service superiority."

The session on business ethics, yielded discussion of a variety of issues such as the importance of having a commitment to Nesma's ethics policy, understanding how to report and handle ethics breaches and strategies for supporting an awareness of ethics throughout the Group.
