

# Nesma Trading Builds KSA's Largest Integrated Logistics Center



Nesma Trading has successfully completed work for Binzagr Company on a project that is the largest integrated logistics center in Saudi Arabia. Operations at the center began in the Industrial Valley in King Abdullah Economic City (KAEC).

The center is one of the largest in the region, with an area of 97,000 square meters and a capacity of more than 110,000 pallets for storing medical and food products.

It includes 50-meter high shelves that operate automatically with the latest technologies for storing and rearranging goods, in addition to 56 gates to receive all types of trucks, and enough parking space to facilitate 180 trucks' loading and unloading at the same time.

Nesma is proud to be part of a project that is taking action to attract local and global investments, enabling the Kingdom to create jobs and contribute to the logistics sector.
