## Nesma Catering & Guinness Book of World Records

Nesma has sponsored Zadk Saudi Culinary Academy since its inception in 2016. On the occasion of Saudi National Day, the students undertook the challenge of creating the world's largest Saudi flag made of cupcakes. The task required careful planning and preparation. The 10- by 15-meter mosaic consisted of approximately 15,000 cupcakes that were created by students at the Academy, stored in a Nesma Catering warehouse and then brought to Rashid Mall in Al Khobar to be assembled into a national-flag mosaic display for the public.

The students' efforts won a coveted spot in the Guinness Book of World Records. The entire project was supervised and guided by Nesma Catering Compliance Manager, Rock Zoghbi, who ensured the safety of the final product and compliance with the requirements of earning a Guinness World Record.
