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Art, Form & Function: N&P Project in Al Ula



Nesma & Partners has again been tapped to lend a hand in shaping the culturally significant Al Ula region, an area designated for responsible development that meets the Royal Commission for AlUla's vision of a world heritage destination exemplifying nature conservation and collaboration with local community.

The Ashar Electrification Project, which began in June of last year and valued at over 200 million SAR, is a power substation and network incorporating cutting-edge technology in its design while drawing inspiration from the ancient Nabataean structures nearby, which in turn, mimic naturally occurring spaces and masses in the wind sculpted rock. The precast and perforate skin of the building aids in efficiently cooling and ventilating while blending with the beautiful, red desert landscape of Al Ula.

This project, with its aesthetic, environmentally and culturally sensitive design, is shortlisted for the World Architecture Festival Award and complements the Vision 2030 goal to implement the latest technologies and design artistry.

Nesma & Partners' slogan is "Together, we build excellence," and with Ashar Electrification Plant project we had the opportunity to realize the vision that the Royal Commission for AlUla has for this wondrous landscape and cultural heritage. It's an honor for Nesma & Partners to work on this prestigious project that allows us to demonstrate our values of "excellence" and "impact."

NUI Begins Professional Verification Training

Nesma United Industries' has begun preparing employees for the government's Professional Verification that aims to ensure the competence of skilled workers from abroad.

NUI's process involved identifying the relevant electrical and plumbing employees and the most highly skilled among them. Then, "champions" were chosen to coach their colleagues using specially developed materials which had been translated into common languages. More than 100 employees in Khobar were trained. The final step is to bring the process to sites in Riyadh, Jeddah, Jazan and Tabuk.

Around 400 employees will benefit from this training program designed to increase success rates and reduce overall costs.



N&P Certified On Environmental ISO



Nesma & Partners, already certified as compliant with ISO 18001:2007 for occupational health & safety (OHS) and the updated 45001:2018 for OHS management systems, has now completed the ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System (EMS) certification process. According to ISO, the International Organization for Standardization, the 45001 "helps organizations improve their environmental performance through more efficient and sustainable use of resources and reduction of waste, gaining a competitive advantage."

With this move, N&P jumps ahead of the game as Saudi Aramco has expressed a new requirement for contractors to be certified with the EMS standard as of January 2022. Meeting both the 14001 and the 45001 for OHS is a milestone achievement for Nesma & Partners. The OHS standards helped employees identify and be aware of potential accident risks demonstrating N&P's commitment to employee safety; whereas, meeting the new EMS standards shows the company's sense of responsibility towards the environment.

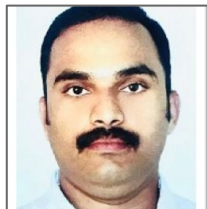

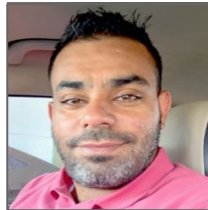
