Nesma Wins Utility Scale PV Project



The Renewable Energy Project Development Office of Saudi Arabia's Ministry of Energy has awarded a 300 MW solar power plant project to a consortium including Nesma Renewable Energy (NRE), Masdar and EDF Renewables. The plant will utilize the latest photovoltaics technology with bifacial solar modules that capture light from both sides of the panels, single-axis solar tracking and state-of-the-art robots that will clean the solar modules.

The photovoltaic project complements the 400 MW Dumat al Jandal wind power farm currently under construction in the north of the Kingdom.

Consortium partner EDF Renewables is a subsidiary of the French utility EDF Group. Masdar is a renewable energy company based in Abu Dhabi, UAE and operating in over 30 countries.

Construction has already begun on the project which is located in Third Jeddah Industrial City 50 km southeast of Jeddah on land roughly equivalent in size to 1000 football fields. Operation is expected to begin in 2022.



“Once completed, the site will be truly impressive,” says NRE’s CEO Amaan Lafayette, “and hopefully, renewable energy sites like it will become a familiar part of the KSA landscape in the coming years. The NRE team is committed to making this vision a reality.”

Nesma Water & Energy Wins Water Treatment Plant Project



A consortium consisting of French company Engie, Nesma Water & Energy and Mowah have been awarded the Yanbu-4 reverse osmosis independent water plant project which will bring clean drinking water from Ar Rayis on the Red Sea coast of Saudi Arabia to the cities of Madinah and Makkah. This reverse osmosis desalination project is unique as it includes solar energy integration to lower electrical consumption, provides for a 2-day back-up supply of 900,000 cubic meters' stored water and is the first public-private partnership, meaning the plant and water pipeline will be operated by the private sector for 25 years under a purchase agreement with the Saudi Water Partnership Company or SWPC.



The project will provide approximately 500 direct and indirect jobs during the construction and operation phases in alignment with strategic objectives contained in Vision 2030.

The plant is expected to be operational by the end of 2023 and will help meet growing water demand in the region while contributing to the Kingdom's socio-economic development.

NT&T Wins Street Lighting Project

Nesma Telecom & Technology has been awarded Jeddah City Phase 4 Package, a Jeddah streetlight retrofit project which will replace 71K existing lamps with LED lighting. The project scope includes lighting fixture supply, design support and technical assistance.

The project, which addresses Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 objective to reduce energy consumption along with associated government expenditures, was awarded by Tarshid.



Nesma's Fadhili is Largest Bachelor Camp

The Fadhili bachelor camp is ready for residents to move in. Having completed its engineering, procurement and construction work on the 760,000 m2 camp which meets Mowaamah disability requirements, Nesma will now manage the project. Able to accommodate 2500 employees, the camp is also designed for a healthy work-life balance with gymnasium, basketball court, games, movie theater, soccer field, tennis courts, swimming pool and more. At the center of the camp are the grand mosque and community center. The camp also has a fire station and medical clinic. Landscaped areas were designed to conserve water and focus on sustainability.

NHTI Designated as Official SVP Exam Center



Nesma High Training Institute or NHTI, has been designated by the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development (HRSD) as an official exam center for the new “Professional Verification” program set to begin operations in July. The program, which covers over 1,000 different professions, requires all foreign skilled workers both abroad and domestic to verify their skills by passing an examination. The goal of the program is to regulate the labor market in Saudi Arabia, raise the overall level of skill and provide job opportunities for skilled Saudi workers.
