Celebrating 2024



A look back on Nesma Insider 2024 reveals two main interconnected themes permeating our Group's events: innovation and a drive to manifest Vision 2030. The Company's mission is to bring innovative ideas to life in business and society.

Vision 2030 is itself a master plan of innovation and the many alliances that Nesma companies have made, the projects pursued and won, the support shown for our Nesma family and for the communities in which we work all support that master plan.

Innovating: Projects, Companies, Alliances, Products & Services

Nesma companies aligned their goals and objectives with those of Vision 2030 and consequently, made many strategic alliances, formed new companies, won large contracts and innovated products & services.

Projects

A consortium of Nesma, Aljomaih Energy and Water Co. and Buhur for Investment Co. was named the preferred bidder for a water transmission project.

Nesma United Industries (NUI) won multiple contracts at Kingdom giga-projects for landscaping, O&M and EPC. NUI also delivered EPC Qiddiya and Aramco VIP Visitor Center projects.

Nesma Infrastructure & Technology (NIT) won critical electric infrastructure and infrastructure security contracts. Also, Ministry of Energy officials visited and praised a NUI project site in NEOM.

Modern Bus Co. received an official visit from the Deputy Governor of Makkah Region.

Nesma Security won a security contract for a Public Investment Fund project.

Both Nesma Water & Energy (NW&E) consortium desalination plants began commercial production and began their 25-year operations and water purchase contracts. Also, the NW&E & Al Moayyed Contracting's Khalifa City Water Distribution Station in Bahrain was inaugurated by Bahraini and Saudi VIPs.

Namma Cargo Services began overseeing the construction of a warehouse for iHerb.

Namma Mawaddah Hotel located near the Masjid Al Haram in Makkah had a grand reopening.

Alliances


