

Spacemaker New Modular Line

Spacemaker has launched an innovative modular unit that facilitates significantly more sustainable construction with shorter ROI times, addressing the Kingdom's high demand for upscale hospitality and residential buildings. Measuring eight meters by four meters by three meters high and meeting the Kingdom's construction codes, the modular units can be used to create any type of space within a building. Developed by the Spacemaker R&D team, these units can shorten construction time by 70%. For example, a 100-room, 3-star hotel that would normally take 18 months for construction, can be completed within five months using Spacemaker modules. Demonstrating the company's focus on sustainability, the uniform units are manufactured in a factory-controlled setting. consequently, waste, CO2 emissions and construction risk are all minimized in the field.

Spacemaker created a hotel mock-up made entirely of the new modular units which was unveiled at a launch ceremony attended by senior management from Nesma United Industries and a representative from the Public Investment Fund (PIF), underscoring the strong partnerships that are essential to the company's continued growth and success.

This new modular building line represents a transformative step for Spacemaker, enabling faster, more efficient and sustainable building processes for their clients.

In a September 30th pledge-signing ceremony with Alsulaiman Group, Nesma joined a Ministry of Economy and Planning (MEP) "Sustainability Champions" program and is now in the preliminary stages of developing a Group-wide sustainability strategy. What is sustainability in this context? It is a focus across business sectors on fulfilling the Vision 2030 goals of a vibrant economy and reduced emissions through protecting the planet, from how we use natural resources to construction methods, energy production, energy management, waste management, responsible manufacturing methods and responsible consumption.

The goal of the Ministry's program is to recruit and mentor leading companies, such as Nesma, to be "sustainability champions" by first enhancing their own sustainability practices and then, in turn, collaborating with other companies to create a lasting impact throughout the Kingdom.

This begins with training and compiling comprehensive technical data. Enhanced sustainability strategies will be implemented first by Nesma Co. before input is solicited from executive teams across the Group and customized sustainability programs are developed for each Nesma company.

The MEP Sustainability Champions program aligns with the Vision 2030 goal of zero emissions by 2060 and is part of a broader commitment to sustainable development.

Bandar Alsemiery, President Assistant - Projects Affairs, spearheaded the initiative and represented Nesma Co. at the signing ceremony, after which a team was established under Hisham Al-Obaidi, Chief Compliance Officer, to implement the program.

In an official communication about this program to Nesma CEOs, Vice President Noura Alturki wrote, "This program presents a significant opportunity for Nesma and its subsidiaries to enhance our sustainability practices and contribute to a greener future. We look forward to working together to achieve our shared sustainability goals."
