

Nesma Holding Recognized for Jubail–Buraydah Water Project



The Jubail–Buraydah Independent Water Transmission Project, developed with Nesma's participation, has been awarded the 2025 Middle East and Africa PPP Deal of the Year by PFI, the leading global platform for project finance reporting and information.

Jubail Buraydah IWTP was selected amongst a number of other projects competing for this award and the recognition highlights the project's strategic importance, innovative financing structure and contribution to strengthening regional water infrastructure. The award was announced in PFI's Special Reports issue published in mid-December 2025 and the awards will be given in London on February 2026 at the awards ceremony.

Indeed, PFI award is an important industry led recognition for Jubail Buraydah IWTP project and yet another proud moment for Nesma and the team involved in this project. Jubail Buraydah's unique and first time record breaking Islamic financing for such a type of project has paved the way for other water transmission PPPs to follow.

energy projects. The BESS will mitigate the effects of energy intermittency, ensuring a stable supply of electricity to meet the

growing demand. These schemes will be the largest battery energy storage system in Central Asia and is part of the country's

growing renewables and independent power programme designed to replace old coal-fired plants.

MIDDLE EAST AND AFRICA PPP DEAL OF THE YEAR: JUBAIL-BURAYDAH IWTP

The Al-Jubail Energy & Water, Bahr Investment and Nesma team put together one of the most impressive infrastructure deals in the region – the SR8.5bn (US\$2.3bn) Jubail–Buraydah independent water transmission pipeline project in Saudi Arabia.

The deal is backed by a US\$1.7bn Islamic project financing deal from the Saudi National Infrastructure Fund, AICB, Saudi Awwal Bank, The Arab Energy Fund, PAF, Saudi Investment Bank and Bank Aljazira.

There is a US\$1.2bn independent power bridge via Al Bilad Bank, Al Rajhi and Saudi Investment Bank. The deal was the largest ever private sector participation in a water project. It is denominated in US dollars and has a five year toll to the concession.

The independent water transmission cost bid of SR3.59468/m³ (US\$0.934/m³) and was awarded the scheme in late 2024. The 40.00m/day desalination plant will be operated by a 35-year water transmission agreement with a four-year construction phase.

The project will have a storage capacity of 1,634,000m³ and the pipeline will run for 587km. It is backed by Ministry of Finance credit support to procure Saudi Water Project.

The scheme will link the Eastern Province with the Qassim Region.

It added an element of unique financing. Compared to the earlier rounds of PFI's including the Rayy, Rabigh IWTP and Ras Madanah schemes, Jubail will be a significant jump in scale which led to unique characteristics such as the routing considerations.

Under the concession the private-sector project company will build the pipeline system, operate it and transfer the assets to the government at the end of the 35-year period.

Al-Jubail will hold 45% of the project

company, Bahr Investment, 35% and Nesma, 20%. The EPC for the project is being undertaken by Muttah Al-Ghawari & Partners.

Crampore was the financial adviser to the sponsors and Piment Masons was the legal adviser. Herbert Smith Freehills was the lenders' adviser. Synergy Consulting, DLA Piper and Fazlani advised SWPC.

NIT Secures Two Major SEC Contracts in Jubail



Nesma Infrastructure & Technology (NIT) has secured two major contracts with the Saudi Electricity Company (SEC) to strengthen power infrastructure in Jubail, with a combined value exceeding SAR 1.48 billion.

The first contract, signed in December 2025, covers the replacement of the Jubail North 230/34.5 kV BSP, valued at over SAR 640 million, with a delivery period of 24 months. The second contract involves the replacement of the Jubail Southeast 230/115/34.5 kV substation, including associated overhead transmission line works, valued at over SAR 840 million and scheduled for completion within 20 months.

Both projects focus on upgrading high-voltage substations and integrating them with the national grid, enhancing reliability and capacity in one of the Kingdom's most critical industrial regions. The scope includes advanced engineering works, multi-voltage system coordination and careful execution to maintain grid stability, aligning with SEC's objectives for a more resilient and modern power network under Saudi Vision 2030.
